



I. Rules Governing site Use

A. Procedures for use

- i. Never give out identifying information such as home address, school name, or telephone number.
- ii. Let parents or guardians decide whether personal information such as age, marital status, or financial information should be revealed.
- iii. Never arrange a face-to-face meeting with someone via the computer without parents' or guardians' approval.
- iv. Never respond to messages that are suggestive, obscene, threatening, or make one uncomfortable.
- v. Have parents or guardians report an incident to the National Center for Missing and Exploited Children at 1-800-843-5678 if one becomes aware of the transmission of child pornography.
- vi. Remember that people online may not be who they say they are.
- vii. Remember that everything one reads may not be true.

Users may not:

- i. Distribute unsolicited advertising.
- ii. Invade the privacy of others.
- iii. Engage in any activity that is harassing or defamatory.
- iv. disrupt the normal flow of dialogue, cause a screen to "scroll" faster than other users of the service are able to type, or otherwise act in a manner that negatively affects other users' ability to engage in real time exchanges.
- v. impersonate any person or entity, including, but not limited to, a teacher, forum leader, guide or host, or falsely state or otherwise misrepresent your affiliation with a person or entity;
- vi. upload, post, email, transmit or otherwise make available any Content that is unlawful, harmful, threatening, abusive, harassing, tortious, defamatory, vulgar, obscene, libelous, invasive of another's privacy, hateful, or racially, ethnically or otherwise objectionable;
- vii. You understand and recognize that all content (e.g. gifs, jpegs, banners, mpegs, code) is the sole property of biomatrix2000.com and/or it's affiliates and any misrepresentation, copying, alterations or other improper and false use will constitute an unlawful act.

B. Consequences of non-compliance
